CHECK-IN - Between 12:30 PM and 1:00 PM on Saturday. Scouts and their dads will be assigned a campsite with other Scouts and their dads. Check-in will not begin before 12:30 PM. Check-out by 10:00 AM on Sunday.

MEALS – After checking in, participants will get settled in their campsite and eat lunch. Lunch on Saturday is not provided so you must bring a bag lunch or eat before you arrive. Dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday will be provided in the Dining Hall. You will need to plan to accommodate for any food allergies.

LODGING - Platform tents and adirondacks are provided but you are welcome to bring your own tent if you would like. Please note, no youth will stay in a tent or adirondack with an adult other than his own legal parent or guardian, no exceptions. Access to running water in bathrooms & showers is available.

ACTIVITIES - Throughout the day, Scouts may participate in activities inspired by Leonard da Vinci and his amazing designs and imagination. Activities will include catapults, simple machines, bridge building, shooting, and more! All activities are optional and scheduled for you to participate in at your leisure.

COST - The Early bird cost is \$40.00 for one dad and one Scout, additional Scouts are \$20 each. **The Early Bird deadline is June 2.** After the Early Bird deadline, the cost is \$50.00 for one dad and Scout, additional Scouts are \$25.00 each. All Early Bird registrations are guaranteed a patch at the event. All others may receive the patch after the event.

No walk-ins will be accepted. Saturday dinner, Sunday breakfast, crafts, and a patch are included in your fee. **No registrations will be accepted after June 30.** Refund requests are only accepted until June 28th. All refunds are subject to 5% cancellation fee.
